so far he removes our transgressions from us.**

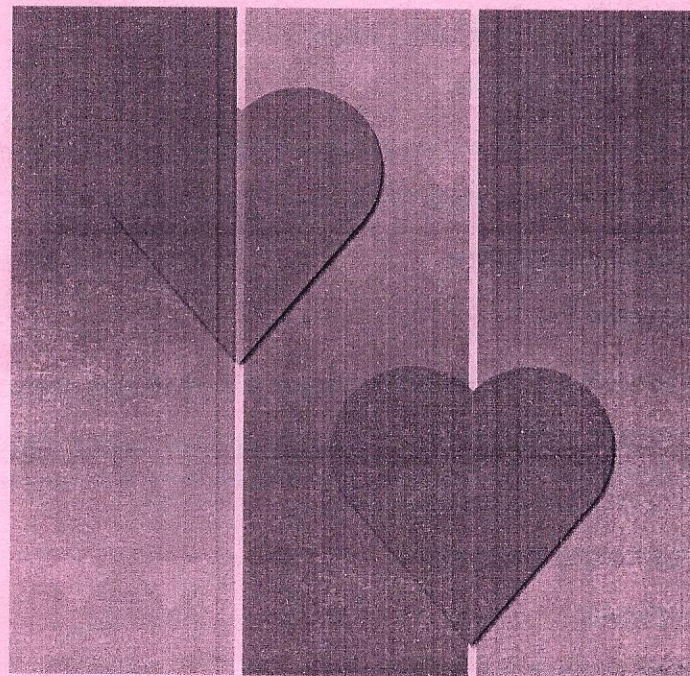
As a father has compassion for his children,
