he lifts those who have fallen.

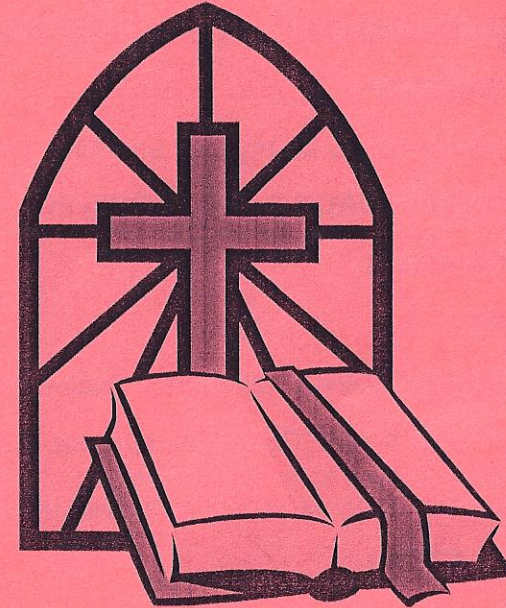
**The LORD is righteous in all he does,
