Samuel also called on his name.**

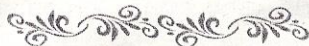
They cried to the Lord for help,

SESSION: *Tues., March 4* – Committees meet at 6:30 p.m. followed by Session at 7:15 p.m.

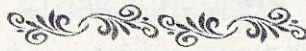
