He has sent redemption to His people.

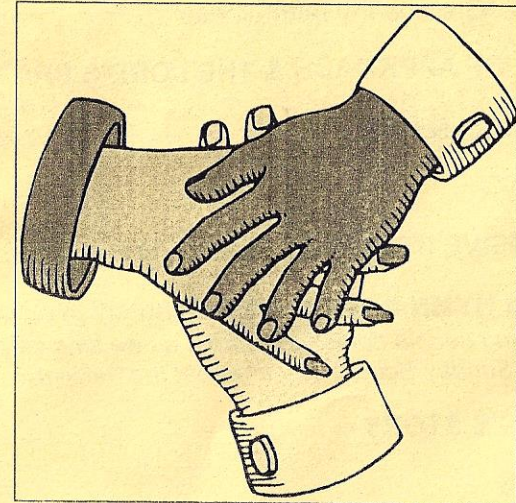
He has ordained His covenant forever.
